1. AT4U is NOT a taxi service, it is a not-for-profit. It is a joined up service with 3 organisations providing the service for your benefit.
2. Members have standard charges for journeys which includes "dead" miles-travelling empty to/from locations. **Charges cover our costs only.** Members should contact us for quote before booking.
3. We operate from Bristol to anywhere in mainland Britain.
4. You get a monthly invoice to be paid upon receipt. We do charge late payment fees and interest. **DO NOT PAY DRIVER.**
5. To book – your calls are always actioned – please leave a message including your phone number and as much information regarding your enquiry/booking as possible to help us reply fully so we can try to help.
6. To pay: bank details on invoice, credit/debit card, cheque or postal order.
7. We do charge abort fees if you have not told us to cancel the booking and we come to pick you up.
8. **Wheelchair users must use their wheelchair/scooter seat belt.** Our seat belts secure member and wheelchair, but for personal safety always use your seat belt. Our drivers can refuse to take you if they feel you are not safe.
